



PROGRESS REPORT ON THE SCHOOL

To God be the glory for the great things He is doing among the pupils in the school and the good image He has giving to the school. Since the dedication of the school, a clip of which was shown on Lesotho Television, news of the school has spread round the country. We trust God to sustain the good image He has given the school.

The school resumed for the third quarter on Monday August 6, 2010. At resumption, one of the guards was sacked for negligence of duty and a new one has been employed. Likewise, a new teacher has been employed to handle one of the new classes.

The items brought by African Missions during dedication are being put into use. The laptops are yet to be used because of lack of electricity. We do not want to risk using the generating set to power them.

As reported in the last report, proper drainage system has been constructed to avoid flooding during incessant downpour.

Below is the extracts from the speech of the Head Teacher during the dedication ceremony concerning some areas of needs.

While responding to the kind and good gesture of African mission, the Head teacher enumerated some items that that are pressing needs in the school. By the grace of God, the school is sustaining itself, but the list of things listed is capital consuming in nature. Since the school is still at the infant stage, assistance will be needed to put these things in place. Below is the list of the things that require urgent attention. As the school progresses, we trust God to attend to some of these needs.

1. Chairs and tables in nine classrooms.
2. Electrification of the school's premises. The school uses generator which is not ideal for powering the computers and the photocopying machine.
3. Installation of burglary proofs to compliment the efforts of the two guards employed.
4. Paving the floor because of rain. We are looking at planting grass because of the cost of paving bricks. It is very expensive.
5. The construction of a security post.
6. The painting of the classrooms.

The pupils are very happy and healthy. LIMPHO RAKUBUTOONE, the HIV orphaned girl is doing very fine. She went for a medical check up according to the Head Teacher during my last visit to the school.
